**MUNICIPAL ORDER OF THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, KENTUCKY,  
REQUIRING PROPOSED LEGISLATION BE POSTED ON CITY'S WEBSITE  
IN ADVANCE OF PUBLIC MEETINGS**

**WHEREAS**, to foster public engagement and discussion of City issues, the City desires to make resolutions, municipal orders, executive orders, and ordinances ("Proposed Legislation") available to the public prior to public meetings;


**WHEREAS**, the City hereby directs the City Clerk to post Proposed Legislation on the City's website prior to any public meeting at which the City intends to discuss the Proposed Legislation;

**BE IT ORDERED** that the City Clerk shall take action to amend the City's website to create a section entitled "Proposed Legislation."


**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED** that absent extraordinary circumstances, the City Clerk shall post Proposed Legislation on the City's website under the section entitled "Proposed Legislation" at least 72 hours prior to the public meeting at which the City intends to discuss the Proposed Legislation.
