ORDINANCE NO. 18, 2013

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION X OF ORDINANCE NO. 5-2000 BY INCORPORATING THE REMOVAL PROCESS SET FORTH IN SECTION 92.05A OF THE CODE FOR DEAD OR DISEASED TREES ON PRIVATE PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, the City has determined that dead or dying trees constitute an imminent danger to the health and safety of Park Hills residents and their property;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, KENTUCKY:

SECTION I

That Section X of Ordinance No. 5-2000 is hereby amended as follows:

The City shall have the right to cause the removal of any dead or diseased trees on private property including within abutting rights-of-way within the City when such trees constitute a potential threat to other trees, property, or persons within the City. Said trees constitute an imminently dangerous condition and may be removed pursuant to the provisions set forth in Section 92.05A of the Code. The City Tree Board will notify in writing the owners of such trees. Removal shall be done by said owners at their own expense within thirty days after the date of service of notice. In the event of failure of owners to comply with such provisions, the City shall have the authority to remove such trees and charge the cost of removal on the owner's property tax notice.

SECTION II

Any and all ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance shall be, and hereby are, repealed to the extent of said conflict.

SECTION III

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, publication, which may be in summary form, and recording, according to law.
