## **ORDINANCE NO. 16, 2017**

AN ORDINANCE: (A) REQUIRING ALL TRAFFIC ON AUDUBON ROAD APPROACHING THE INTERSECTION OF AUDUBON ROAD AND THE FUTURE LOCATION OF WALD COURT, FROM THE EAST AND THE WEST, TO COME TO A COMPLETE STOP BEFORE PROCEEDING THROUGH SAID INTERSECTION, AND (B) REQUIRING ALL TRAFFIC GOING NORTH ON THE FUTURE LOCATION OF WALD COURT TO COME TO A COMPLETE STOP AT THE INTERSECTION WITH AUDUBON ROAD BEFORE **PROCEEDING** THROUGH SAID INTERSECTION, AND (C) AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION STOP SIGNS AND OTHER WARNINGS AT THAT INTERSECTION

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Park Hills, Kentucky finds and determines that the safety and general welfare of its residents and visitors requires that all traffic on Audubon Road approaching the intersection of Audubon Road and the future location of Wald Court, from the east and the west, may proceed through said intersection only after having first brought their vehicle to a complete stop, and that all traffic going north on the future location of Wald Court to come to a complete stop at the intersection with Audubon Road before proceeding through said intersection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, KENTUCKY, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. All traffic on Audubon Road approaching the intersection of Audubon Road and the future location of Wald Court, from the east and the west, may proceed through said intersection only after having first brought their vehicle to a complete stop.

<u>Section 2</u>. All traffic going north on the future location of Wald Court approaching the intersection with Audubon Road may proceed through said intersection only after having first brought their vehicle to a complete stop.

Section 3. The Director of Public Works or his delegate shall forthwith post stop signs and paint the rights of way indicating that it is unlawful for traffic proceeding east and west on Audubon Road to proceed through the intersection of Audubon Road and the future location of Wald Court unless only after having first brought their vehicle to a complete stop, and that it is unlawful for traffic proceeding north on the future location of Wald Court to proceed through the intersection with Audubon Road unless only after having first brought their vehicle to a complete stop.

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force when passed, published and recorded according to the law.
