ORDINANCE NO. 1, 2017

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, KENTUCKY, TO DESIGNATE ABERDEEN ROAD AS A ONE-WAY STREET, WITH TRAFFIC FLOW ONLY PERMITTED IN A WESTERLY DIRECTION UPHILL FROM ARLINGTON ROAD

WHEREAS, under the direction of the City Council of the City of Park Hills, Aberdeen Road was reconstructed by the City and designed to be a residential street with on-street parking and one-way traffic; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Park Hills believes that the designation of Aberdeen Road as a one-way street serves the best interests of residents of the City and promotes public safety.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, KENTUCKY:

Section 1

That Aberdeen Road is designated as a one-way street, with traffic flow only permitted in a westerly direction uphill from Arlington Road. No person shall operate a motor vehicle, bicycle or other device used for transportation in an unauthorized direction on Aberdeen Road.

Section 2

The Public Words Department is authorized and instructed to install appropriate signage giving public notice of the designation authorized under this Ordinance.

Section 3

Any person found in violation of this Ordinance shall be fined according to §10.99 of the Code of Ordinances.

Section 4

That should any section or part of any section or any provision of this Ordinance be declared invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, for any reason, such declaration shall not invalidate, or adversely affect, the remainder of this Ordinance.
