ORDINANCE NO. 5, 2014

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PARK HILLS ("THE CITY"), IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, FIXING THE SALARIES OF THE CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS AT \$1,200.00 PER YEAR

WHEREAS, despite inflation, the salaries of Council members of the City of Park Hills have not changed in 16 years;

WHEREAS, the average salary for Council members of fourth-class cities in Kenton County, Kentucky is \$1,621.01¹;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, KENTUCKY:

SECTION I

That the salary of Council members of the City of Park Hills be fixed at One Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00) per year, payable semi-annually, effective January 1, 2015.

SECTION II

Any and all ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance shall be, and hereby are, repealed to the extent of said conflict.

SECTION III

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, publication, which may be in summary form, and recording, according to law.

Passed by the City Council this 14 day of April, 2014.

¹ This number results from analyzing data from the Northern Kentucky Area Development District ("NKADD"). The NKADD received salary reports from Crescent Springs, Edgewood, Elsmere, Fort Mitchell, Fort Wright, Ludlow, Taylor Mill, and Villa Hills and \$1,6221.01 constitutes the average Council member salary for those cities.
