### **ORDINANCE NO. 6, 2016**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AMENDING CHAPTER 30.100 OF THE ORDINANCES TO SEPARATE THE PARK HILLS CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD FROM THE PARK HILLS NUISANCE BOARD

WHEREAS, the City amended its nuisance code and now desires to separate the Park Hills Nuisance Board from the Code Enforcement Board;

# BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, KENTUCKY:

#### SECTION 1

Chapter 30.100 PURPOSE

The purpose of this subchapter is to create the City Code Enforcement [and Nuisance] Board (the "Board") having the power under the Local Government Enforcement Board Act, being KRS 65.8801 to 65.8839, to issue remedial orders and impose civil fines when a violation of an ordinance has been classified as a civil offense.

## **SECTION 2**

Any and all Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance shall be, and hereby are, repealed to the extent of said conflict.

# **SECTION 3**

If any part of this Ordinance or its application is deemed invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the city council intends that such invalidity will not affect the effectiveness of the remaining provisions or applications and, to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are severable.

### **SECTION 4**

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, publication, which may be in summary form, and recording, according to law.
