THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, KENTUCKY ORDINANCE NO. 17, 2011

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, KENTUCKY: (I) AMENDING THE DEFINITION OF FULL-TIME-WORKER WITHIN THE PERSONNEL POLICIES OF THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, KENTUCKY WITH REGARD TO THE PART-TIME POSITION OF POLICE CLERK, AND (II) AUTHORIZING SUMMARY PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, KENTUCKY, as follows:

<u>Section One.</u> The *Definitions* of the Park Hills Personnel Policies be, and they are, amended to read as follows:

<u>Full-time-worker</u> – A worker who works on a continuing basis, a standard 40 hour work week, with the exception of the police clerk and the assistant city clerk who <u>works</u> work 30 hours a week, who <u>is</u> are classified as full time.

<u>Section Two</u>. That if any provision of this ordinance is deemed by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unenforceable or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall continue in full force and effect.

<u>Section Three.</u> That all other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

<u>Section Four</u>. That this Ordinance shall take full force and effect upon publication as required by KRS Chapter 424 and other applicable law. This Ordinance shall be published in summary form pursuant to KRS §83A.060(9) and other applicable law.
