

ORDINANCE 116 - 2016

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, KENTUCKY TO ERECT A BARRIER ACROSS OLD STATE ROAD AT ITS EASTERN END AT THE WESTERN BOUNDARY OF PROPERTY LOCATED AT 1030 OLD STATE ROAD

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Park Hills has determined that Old State Road is a small residential street that cannot support the increase in traffic that may accompany the development of property east of Arlington Road;

WHEREAS, in order to prevent the increase in traffic, from the effective date of this ordinance forward the City shall erect a barrier at the eastern end of Old State Road at the western boundary of property located at 1030 Old State Road;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, KENTUCKY:

Section 1

That the City erect a barrier at the eastern end of Old State Road at the western boundary of property located at 1030 Old State Road.

Section 2

The Public Works Department is authorized and instructed to install appropriate signage and barriers to give the public notice of the actions authorized under this Ordinance.

Section 3


That should any section or part of any section or any provision of this Ordinance be declared invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, for any reason, such declaration shall not invalidate, or adversely affect, the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 4

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force when passed, published and recorded according to the law.

PASSED by the City Council this 14 day of November, 2016.


