Ordinance No. 3, 2015

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FROM THE POLICE DEPARTMENT MAINTENANCE AND REPLACEMENT RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, Chapter 33.06 of the Municipal Code provides for the Police Department Maintenance and Replacement Reserve Fund to set aside funds for expenditures for operating, replacing, and improving the equipment used or required by the Park Hills Police Department;

WHEREAS, Chapter 33.06 of the Municipal Code requires that expenditures from the Police Department Maintenance and Replacement Reserve Fund be approved by ordinance;

WHEREAS, an emergency exists and is declared with respect to this ordinance. For the safety of its citizens and police officers, Park Hills desires to have its police officers wear body cameras. It is urgent that the City purchase two more body cameras in order to sufficiently supply its Police Department.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, KENTUCKY:

SECTION 1

City Council authorizes Chief Stanley to spend up to \$1,500.00 from the Police Department Maintenance and Replacement Reserve Fund to purchase two body cameras.

SECTION 2

Any and all ordinances in conflict with this ordinance shall be, and hereby are, repealed to the extent of said conflict.

SECTION 3

For the reasons set forth above, an emergency is declared to exist and the provisions of this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by a vote of 2/3 or more of the legislative body.
