MUNICIPAL ORDER NO. 5, 2021

AN ORDER OF THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, KENTUCKY AUTHORIZING THE POLICE CHIEF TO APPLY FOR AND THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A LAW ENFORCEMENT PROTECTION PROGRAM BODY-WORN CAMERA GRANT APPLICATION WITH THE KENTUCKY OFFICE OF HOMELAND SECURITY

WHEREAS, KRS 16.220 established a fund within the Kentucky Office of Homeland Security to provide grants for the acquisition of various weapons and equipment for use by law enforcement agencies, including city Police Departments, through its Law Enforcement Protection Program; and,

WHEREAS, a Grant Award Process has been created for law enforcement agencies to submit such grant applications to request eligible items, which includes body cameras; and,

WHEREAS, the Police Department desires to make application for acquisition of the same,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, KENTUCKY, as follows:

SECTION I

That Police Chief Cody Stanley shall be and is hereby authorized to apply for a Law Enforcement Protection Program Body-Worn Camera Grant Application with the Kentucky Office of Homeland Security to acquire eight (8) Halo Body-Worn Cameras for use in the Police Department, as set forth in the Project Information and Funds portion of the Application.

SECTION II

That Mayor Kathy Zembrodt shall be and is hereby authorized to execute the Certificate & Authorization portion of the Grant Application on behalf of the City of Park Hills, Kentucky for submittal to the Kentucky Office of Homeland Security.

SECTION III

That this Order has been approved by Council and shall become effective upon adoption and execution by the Mayor.
