

ORDINANCE NO. 10, 2022

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, KENTUCKY AUTHORIZING THE OPERATION OF GOLF CARTS UPON DESIGNATED PUBLIC ROADWAYS WITHIN THE CITY PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF KRS CHAPTER 189.286.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of KRS 189.286 the operation of golf carts is permitted upon designated public roadways if authorized by local Ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, the provisions of KRS 189.286 (3) through (10) set forth the regulations, requirements and regulations for operation of the same upon designated public roadways,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, KENTUCKY, as follows:

SECTION I

That Pursuant to the provisions of KRS 189.286(2), the operation of golf carts on designated public roadways within the City shall be and is hereby permitted in accordance with the requirements, regulations and restrictions regarding the same as set forth in KRS 189.286 (3) through (10) which provisions are hereby adopted and made a part hereof and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth.

SECTION II

That the public roadways so designated for golf cart operation hereunder shall be, as follows:

All public roadways with a posted speed limit of 20 m.p.h. or less.
However, golf cart shall be prohibited from crossing any portion of Dixie Highway.

SECTION III

That this Ordinance shall be signed by the Mayor, attested to by the City Clerk, published and effective upon publication.

MUNICIPAL ORDER NO. 8, 2022

AN ORDER OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, KENTUCKY, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH COVINGTON CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL CONCERNING THE APPOINTMENT OF A SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER

WHEREAS, Covington Catholic is a private Catholic high school located in Park Hills, Kentucky, and is operated by the Roman Catholic Diocese of Covington; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Park Hills is a city of the Home Rule Class created by Kentucky statute as a corporate entity with capacity to contract and be contracted with, pursuant to KRS Chapters 81 and 83; and,

WHEREAS, it is the intent and desire of the City of Park Hills and Covington Catholic to provide for the services of a School Resource Officer under the circumstances described in the attached Memorandum of Understanding Concerning Appointment of School Resource Officer;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, KENTUCKY as follows:

SECTION I

That Mayor, Kathy Zembrodt, shall be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute the attached Memorandum of Understanding for the appointment of a School Resource Officer (SRO) for Covington Catholic High School, which is made a part hereof and fully incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION II

That this Order shall be signed by the Mayor, attested to by the City Clerk, recorded and effective upon adoption.

MUNICIPAL ORDER NO. 9, 2022

AN ORDER OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, KENTUCKY
AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO MAKE APPLICATION FOR AND
TO ENTER INTO AND EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE
KENTUCKY OFFICE OF HOMELAND SECURITY FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT
PROTECTION PROGRAM FUNDS

BE IT ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARK HILLS,
KENTUCKY, as follows:

SECTION I

That the Mayor shall be and is hereby authorized and directed to make application with the Kentucky Department of Homeland Security (KOHS) for Law Enforcement Protection Program funds for a project to be administered by KOHS, understanding approval of such funds imposes certain obligations and responsibilities upon the City, and to enter into and execute a Memorandum of Agreement and any other documentation deemed necessary by KOHS to facilitate and administer the project, pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth therein, and to allow the Mayor to act as the authorized correspondent for the project.

That this Order has been approved by Council and shall become effective upon adoption and execution by the Mayor.

MUNICIPAL ORDER NO. 10, 2022

AN ORDER OF THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, KENTUCKY AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION WITH PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT SERVICES OF KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY (PDS) FOR CONSIDERATION AND APPROVAL OF A TEXT AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE X, ZONES, SECTION 10.9 D.4., AREA AND HEIGHT REGULATIONS, OF ITS OFFICIAL ZONING CODE TO PERMIT A MINIMUM SIDE YARD WIDTH OF 7.5 FEET FOR BUILDINGS LOCATED WITHIN THE HC (HIGHWAY COMMERCIAL) ZONE

WHEREAS, after discussion and review, Council approved a request for and agreed to make application with Planning and Development Services of Kenton County, Kentucky, to approve a text amendment to Article X, Section 10.9 D.4., of its Official Zoning Code to permit a minimum side yard width (set-back) of 7.5 feet for buildings located within the HC (Highway Commercial) Zone and with such request being in conformity with the Z21 Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OF PARK HILLS, KENTUCKY, as follows:

SECTION I

That an application shall be made by the City (via the Mayor) with Planning and Development Services of Kenton County, Kentucky (PDS) requesting consideration and approval of a text amendment to Article X, Zones, Section 10.9 D., Area and Height Requirements, of the City's Official Zoning Code to permit a minimum side yard width (set-back) of 7.5 feet for buildings located within the HC (Highway Commercial) Zone.

SECTION II

That the City shall thereafter consider the recommendation of PDS before deciding to undertake any amendment to its Official Zoning Code thereby.

SECTION III

That this Order has been approved by Council and shall become effective upon adoption and execution by the Mayor.
