### **Mill and Overlay Plans**

1. Breckinridge – Spring 2022
2. Emerson – Michels has had to push this back
  - We may do the Morgan Court section – timing TBD

### **Sidewalks**

1. St Joes – frustrating Grant process but the Mayor noted that we hope be able to request bids in January 2022
2. Arlington to Hamilton to Trolley Park
  - Jay Bayer is completing Engineering
3. Funding – Borrow or pay from City funds – Finance Committee to review

### **Cleveland Avenue Safety Issues**

1. Large vertical curbs from several years ago resulted in a reduced width as they were constructed on the existing road – not at the side
  - Curbs also limit how close people can park – causing even more reduced width
  - Families walking are at risk due to narrow width and difficult to move off road due to curbs
  - Hill and curves contribute to risk as well
2. Committee discussed removing current curbs and replacing with rolled curbs that attach at the side of the road
  - So gaining lost width which allows cars to park closer to curb
  - Also allows families (strollers) an easier method to get off the road if necessary
  - A bit more review required but the Committee was in agreement that this was a logical more immediate action to improve Safety

### **Amsterdam Road – Sleepy Hollow to Altavia**

1. Deep fix required – working with Kenton County on resolution
2. Cars parking on Amsterdam
  - Sometimes blocking the sidewalk
  - Existing signs denoting no parking during rush hours
    - Signs are worn out and hard to read – Public Works to replace
  - More discussion on topic of No Parking at all

### **Traffic Calming**

1. Speed bumps at Amsterdam/Trolley Park have been effective but are there better ways?
  - Steve Elkins to review all options and bring to committee for further discussions
  - Moving spare Police car to “problem areas”

### **Infrastructure Mobile Committee**

1. Suggested we have a team go and view in person all noted Infrastructure issues (list is not in priority order) – desire is to do this within the next 2 weeks
  - Sidewalks
  - Streets
  - Areas in need of Traffic calming
  - Signage
  - Amsterdam parking issues
  - Park Hills “entrances”
    - Care and maintenance
    - Low budget enhancements
