- Sidewalk on Hamilton – Arlington to Trolley Park
 - Everything is pretty much ready to go
 - Dan will be doing this job with PT help
 - Finding time is the only tracking item
- Speed Humps and Bumps
 - Mayor Zembrodt has provided a draft policy
 - Note: we cannot use the hump at Amsterdam/Trolley Park due to Amsterdam being considered a “Corridor”
 - Other speed calming solutions were discussed as well
 - Flashing “Speed” sign
 - Believed to be an effective deterrent to speeding
 - Mayor Zembrodt to consider purchasing 1 or 2 more
 - Rumble Strips
 - Could be used at Amsterdam/Trolley
 - Tables
- Rain drainage on Emerson Rd – section not completed last year
 - Michaels has spoken to both homeowners and has a plan
 - This project will come after Breckenridge and Cleveland (curbs)
 - Communication required with homeowners to ensure alignment
- Rain drainage issue on Altavia caused by Park Place Condos
 - Mayor Zembrodt has requested PDS enforcement
- City Entrances
 - Brief discussion on the entrance by Notre Dame
 - Committee supports moving ahead
 - Mayor Zembrodt to discuss with the Sisters
 - Pam to request written approval from the land owner of the desired spot for the new sign (in front of the fence)
 - Dan to check with the Highway Department
- Temporary Power/Phone line Pole on Arlington
 - Left behind from Arlington Road project
 - Phone/Cable lines are still attached to the pole solely by rope
 - Pole needs to be moved
 - Mayor Zembrodt to follow up with proper authorities to action
