#### ORDINANCE NO. 4, 2023

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, KENTUCKY AMENDING SECTION 72.02(A) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING STOPPING, STANDING, OR PARKING PROHIBITED IN SPECIFIED PLACES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, KENTUCKY, as follows:

#### SECTION I

That Section 72.02(A) of the Code of Ordinances shall be and is hereby amended to read, as follows:

SEC. 72.02 STOPPING, STANDING, OR PARKING PROHIBITED IN SPECIFIED PLACES.

- (A) Stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles prohibited at the following places:
  - (1) In front of a public or private driveway;
  - (2) Within ten feet of a fire hydrant;
  - (3) On a sidewalk;
  - (4) Within an intersection;
  - (5) On a crosswalk;
  - (6) Within 20 30 feet of a crosswalk intersection;
  - (7) Within 20 30 feet upon the approach to any flashing beacon, stop sign, or traffic control signal located at the side of a highway;
  - (8) In any parkway in any street, or in any parkway dividing two streets;
  - (9) Within ten feet of a driveway, entrance to any fire station, and on the side of a street opposite the entrance to any fire station within 50 feet of said entrance (when properly signposted);

- (10) Alongside or opposite any street excavation or obstruction when such stopping, standing, or parking would obstruct traffic;
- (11) On the roadway side of any vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curb of a street; or
- (12) At any place where official signs or marking prohibits stopping, stalling standing, and parking. No person shall move a vehicle not owned by such person into any such prohibited area or away from a curb such distance as is unlawful.
