1. Project updates

• St. Joseph Lane sidewalk

This project is now underway with an anticipated completion date of mid-June, weather permitting.

• Amsterdam patchwork

The next scheduled work on Amsterdam will focus on the section of Altavia to Sleepy Hollow and spot work near Hillcrest, all to maintain the road until the grant decision allowing a deep fix is received. The City has put more than \$87,000 into Amsterdam since 2021. One of the main problems is broken piping beneath the street that SD-1 never properly fixed. Mayor Zembrodt will check with SD-1 on the status of this fix and report back at the next Infrastructure meeting. **Update: the Committee will discuss a mill-and-overlay for Amsterdam in FY23-24.**

• Developing a full list

• Cleveland (curbs)

Mr. VonHandorf is obtaining bids to complete the next 400 feet of this project, which will take it to Emerson Road, and exploring doing this work himself. Mr. VonHandorf will report back at the next Infrastructure meeting.

• Emerson (water)

Mr. VonHandorf is obtaining bids to address this issue. An initial bid was \$25,000 for piping and \$25,000 to finish the mill-and-overlay.

• Park Road (west side)

This is actually the **east** side of Park Road. No further update was provided.

• Exter to Irish Rose

The mill-and-overlay for this section of road is estimated at \$30,000, though no bids have yet been solicited.

2. FY23-24 planning

The main Infrastructure projects for FY23-24 are as follows. This list and budget will be finalized at the next Committee meeting.

- Amsterdam – patchwork and a potential mill-and-overlay
- Cleveland – curb replacement to Emerson

- Emerson – piping fix and completion of mill-and-overlay
